WHAT IS IT?

It's an associative and self-managed space located in Princesa Street in Barcelona that combines a common habitable use and a working use. The space is conceived to welcome international projects and other associative activities. Ca l'Elna is provided with kitchen, living room, common rooms and a meeting and reunion area.

The main goal is to take in international voluntary work (Workcamps, EVS, LTV...) and international participants from SCI or other organisations that collaborate with SCI.

HOW TO USE IT?

The space it's open to other projects and associative activities, social movements and activists. It is requested to take care of Ca l'Elna and the common resources and to collaborate economically, within the possibilities, to continue the project.

WHO PROMOTES IT?

Ca l'Elna is promoted by Servei Civil Internacional de Catalunya (SCI), which is a non-profit youth association born in 1982 who works for peace culture, global justice and social transformation from an associative and local point of view. Furthermore, Ca l'Elna is a member of the Service Civil International network, one of the most important voluntary work movements and peace activists in the world, and also member of the international platform CCIWS.

With the name of Ca l'Elna we want to remember the importance of the Elna's Maternity, in Catalunya Nord, founded during the end of the Spanish Civil War by Elisabeth Eidenberg, an SCI swiss volunteer. As it was then, Ca l'Elna wants to be a welcoming and international solidarity space: a "peace island", how Elisabeth named it.
