Description: The Popular Struggle Coordination Committee (PSCC) was formed by prominent activists in the Popular Committees from all over the Popular Committees and across the Palestinian political spectrum in order to enhance a productive communication between the different Popular Committees: from the village in Ramallah area (Bil'in, Ni'ilin, Nabi Saleh), Bethlehem (al Maasara, Al Walaja), of the Jordan Valley and South Mount Hebron to Tulkarem, Nablus, Qalqilya; all suffering of various aspects of the occupation. These diverse, non-partisan committees lead community resistance to Israeli occupation in various forms, such as marches, strikes, demonstrations, direct actions and legal campaigns, as well as supporting the campaign of the Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions (BDS).

Type of work: Agricultural and developing activities. Volunteers will help farmers some days. The others they will deal with the cultural center of the village: painting walls, organize the library and the some activities as one intercultural event in the center, and some sports events.

Study Theme: Deep the Palestinian issue

Accommodation: Volunteer will be accommodated in the international guest house. They will sleep in bed or mattresses on the floor, thus each volunteer should bring a sleeping bag or sheets. Volunteers will share the duties of preparing foods, cooking meals and cleaning.
